- A. F.A.C.T.S. Update (Bill Mullane)

- 1. Plantation Island, still looking towards fundraising and grant prospects
- 2. Canals to trails still a topic, specifically Settlers Canal

- B. Chinden corridor plans/ projects

- 1. The City was chosen for a grant to ready an application for a detached (landscape buffer between cars and path) sidewalk or multiuse pathway along Chinden between Glenwood and Maple Grove. We will know if it is formally approved by the COMPASS board in August. This means that a consultant will do an environmental scan, refine the location, and provide a cost estimate. Once this is done the City can seek funding for the exact design and construction.
- 2. The City has requested funding through the COMPASS programs to develop a Chinden redevelopment plan. The anticipated cost is \$200,000. While the project is on the regional corridor list (and I am hopeful will get some support), no funding has been allocated to the project yet.

- C. Glenwood corridor plans

The City continues to work with ITD on Glenwood. Cecilia Awusie with ITD is the project manager. She hopes to be ready for public/stakeholder input in August.

D. Chinden/ Curtis scheduled for construction

1. The Curtis/Chinden intersection is anticipated to be remodeled by ACHD this upcoming year. The City is hoping to be able to install some vegetation to the gateway into Garden City. There are constraints related to trees, so Dallas has the idea of planters that might provide greenery and some pedestrian comfort.

E. Flood Hazard Ordinance adopted

1. The City has adopted the revised flood hazard ordinance. The City is now officially in seclusion.

F. BENCHES

1. Another bench was installed adjacent to Long Lake. Two more benches will be installed likely by the end of next week. One will be at the pollinator garden by City Hall, the will be at Heron Park. This will bring the total number of benches to 8.
