



At a public hearing on 08/28/2023, the Garden City Council approved rate increases for the water, sewer and trash utility funds. These increases will go into effect on 10/01/2023. You will see the increase on your November 2023 billing statement for October's services.

Water Fund

The approved 8% increase anticipates the increase in the cost of services and the water capital fund replacement schedule that has \$1 million in capital projects planned to update aging infrastructure.

Sewer Fund

There are significant changes taking place at the Boise City Water Renewal Treatment Plant. Over the next ten years, Boise City will be investing over \$500 million in the treatment facilities. This investment will not only expand their capacity, but it will also allow them to deal with the expanding federal regulations from the EPA.

Garden City's approved increase consists of two components. The city will receive a 10% increase from Boise City as an end user of the Water Renewal Treatment Plant. This amount is a direct cost pass through to the rate payers. The rate increase will be 8% for residential customers and 15% for commercial customers.

The increase anticipates the increase in the cost of services and the sewer capital fund replacement schedule that has \$5.2 million in capital projects planned to update aging infrastructure.

Trash Fund

The rate increase of 2% is based on the contract price increase with Republic Services and the corresponding price increase at the Ada County Landfill.
