



Garden City Public Hearing City Text Code Amendment

PURSUANT TO ESTABLISHED PROCEDURE, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that there will be a public hearing held, Monday, April 24, 2023, 6:00 p.m. to discuss CPAFY2022-0006 Parking. The City of Garden City is proposing that the city code be amended to improve parking regulations. The purpose of these amendments will be to improve Title 8 for both developers and the City, to make the codified ordinances more uniform and objective, and to ensure the City code aligns with the purpose of Garden City's Comprehensive Plan. Written comments must be received not less than one week ahead of time to be in the packet submitted for review. Written materials may be accepted up to 24 hours prior to the hearing.
