Kelli,

We just received a copy of the comments from the ACHD on the subject project. We note a comment on the alignment of street centerlines for Coffey Street north and south of Chinden. This comment could impact the sewage monitoring station location on the southwest corner of the intersection and perhaps options for connecting the project to sanitary sewer.

It is not clear how the centerlines will align. We presume you will be looking at the issue.

If the west right-of-way of Coffey Street moves to the west, we suspect the monitoring station will conflict with street improvements. It may conflict with proposed street improvements anyway. However there may be an opportunity that opens up to connect to the sewer line in the area. But, the Boise City sludge line could still be a conflict issue along with existing water lines.

The purpose of this e-mail is to let you know the ACHD comments could alter the discussion we recently had on the sewer service for the project. At this time we don't know how it could be altered, but it might.

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
