Aggravated Battery Arrest

Garden City – Garden City Police arrest Cody Sumpter (26) of Garden, Idaho.

Details: On January 10th, 2019, at around 2:30 PM Garden City Police responded to the report of an battery that had just occurred in the 8300 Block of Chinden Blvd. The victim fled the scene and met officers at a local restaurant near Glenwood and Chinden.

Arriving officers found the victim had sustained some lacerations to his head and hand. The 26-year-old victim advised his roommate, Cody Sumpter, attacked him with brass knuckles during a dispute at their residence. Sumpter was reportedly still at the residence when the victim left to meet officers. The victim was later transported via ambulance to an area hospital where he was treated for several non-life threatening injuries.

Officers responded to the residence and learned that Sumpter had already fled the scene and that his whereabouts were unknown. Officers continued to search for Sumpter and he was eventually located during a traffic stop several hours later at the intersection of Coffey and Chinden, and he was taken into custody without incident.

At the time of this media release the investigation is still on going, and may result in additional criminal charges.

Sumpter was transported to the Ada County Jail where he was booked for Aggravated Battery (Felony), he will be arraigned in Magistrate Court tomorrow at 1:30 PM.
