On July 13, 2018, at about 5:15pm, Garden City Police and Ada County Paramedics were called to the scene to an injury accident on Chinden Boulevard just west of Dresden.

It was determined that an adult male (66 years old from Boise) was walking north across Chinden when he was struck by a motor vehicle travelling east on Chinden. He was not walking across in a marked cross-walk.

CPR and live saving measures were started on scene and the male was transported to Saint Alphonus. The male pedestrian did not respond to treatment and was ultimately declared deceased.

The female driver was not injured.

Due to the fatal injury that was sustained in this accident and evidence found at the scene, the Ada County CRASH reconstruction Team responded to investigate the accident. Further investigation and evidence processing are being conducted before any decisions on charges are made.

Traffic for both westbound and eastbound on Chinden Boulevard was partially blocked for several hours during the investigation.

The name of the male pedestrian is not being released at this time pending family notification.
